The number of bowling balls a student-athlete can use in the Intercollegiate Singles Championships is limited to five bowling balls. This card should be completed by the student-athlete and presented at registration.

All bowling balls must meet USBC specifications and be included on the list of USBC-approved balls posted on BOWL.com. However, certain bowling balls are ineligible for competition, even if they appear on the approved list. This includes all slow oil-absorbing high-performance bowling ball (Urethane) models listed in the section below, as well as any slow oil-absorbing high-performance balls produced prior to Aug. 1, 2022. **The following balls are prohibited for use. 900 Global Altered Reality, 900 Global Wolverine, Roto Grip UFO Alert, Storm Electrify Solid, Storm Phaze 4, Storm Trend 2, 2016 and 2017 Purple Hammer (identified by serial numbers that start with a “6” or “7”).**
