#### ATTENTION, BOWLING CENTER OWNERS, ARCHITECTS AND DESIGNERS:

If you have been involved in the building or renovation of a bowling center, and completed the project after August 1, 2016 — and have not previously entered that center in this competition — then you are invited to enter the 2017 Bowlers Journal International Bowling Center Architecture and Design Awards competition.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. Please fill out this 2-page application form COMPLETELY. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
- **2.** Submissions can be sent electronically or by regular mail. Emailed submissions must be sent to the editor at **bjieditor@gmail.com**. As images sent with any submission must be high-resolution (print quality; 300 dpi minimum), it will be necessary to send images to the editor through a file-sharing platform such as Dropbox or a file-sharing platform of your choice. Mailed entries must include a CD, flash drive or other storage device containing high-resolution images depicting the center, or full-color prints of the center (please use a professional developing company; prints made on home printers are not considered to be "print quality").
- **3.** Suggested but not mandatory: Include a one-page "project sheet," detailing the philosophy behind the facility's design.
- **4.** The entry deadline for this year is **September 1, 2017**. Winners will be featured in the November 2017 issue of *Bowlers Journal International*.

# BOWLING CENTER ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN AWARDS COMPETITION

*BJI* depends greatly on those submitting *BJI* Architecture & Design Awards applications to ensure that entries are placed in proper categories. Please double check the form for accuracy prior to submitting, and feel free to address any questions or concerns to the editor at **bjieditor@gmail.com**.

This year's deadline of **September 1** is a couple weeks earlier than it has been in recent years to allow ample time for *BJI* staff to research each entry for accuracy. Consequently, *BJI* cannot accept any entries beyond that date, as research must begin immediately to ensure the deadline for the November issue is met.

Only center projects completed between August 1, 2016 and September 1, 2017, are eligible to be considered for the 2017 *BJI* Architecture & Design Awards. Any entries for centers found to have been completed outside of that timeframe will be disqualified without notice.

Entries found to have been submitted incorrectly or inaccurately in any category will be disqualified without notice.

Submissions containing images that are not high-resolution (print quality; 300 dpi minimum) will be disqualified without notice.
