

UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS
Board of Directors Meeting
Conducted by Telephone and Videoconference
September 3, 2020

A meeting of the United States Bowling Congress took place on September 3, 2020 via telephone and web conference following notice duly provided. Call to Order

2021 and 2022 USBC Women's Championship Locations

Murphy presented thorough considerations for swapping the 2021 and 2022 USBC Women's Championships host communities and venues. Following Board discussion, along with a question and answer session, **a motion was made to switch the 2021 and 2022 USBC Women's Championships. Motion seconded; approved unanimously.**

Pending approval of the host cities, the 2021 USBC Women's Championships will be scheduled for the National Bowling Stadium in Reno, Nevada. The 2022 USBC Women's Championships will be shifted to Stardust Bowl in Addison, Illinois.
