STARTING YOUR ASSOCIATION'S AWARD PROGRAM

- 1. Board of directors should examine budget to determine budgetary funding potential, constraints, or adjustments that need to be made.
- 2. The president, with board approval, will assign an awards committee.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF AWARDS COMMITTEE

1. DETERMINE WHAT AWARDS BEST SUIT YOUR ASSOCIATION'S BOWLERS

Survey your members to find out what types of recognition they would like - patches, lapel pins, frisbees, pens, deck of cards, bottle openers, etc. - if any.

- 1. Use electronic survey software, such as Survey Monkey
- 2. Survey using email distribution service, such as MailChimp (example survey on pg 2)
- 3. Distributed at the start of the season to each league

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER WHEN DEVELOPING YOUR PLAN

- ACA ORDERING DEADLINE IS January 15
- DETERMINE WHICH AWARDS, HOW MANY AWARDS & QUANTITIES OF EACH
- WORK WITH NEARBY ASSOCIATIONS & COMBINE ORDERS TO SAVE MONEY THROUGH BULK ORDERING
- ORDER IN BULK QUANTITIES FOR MULTIPLE YEARS

3. DETERMINE THE LOGO TO BE UTILIZED ON ALL AWARDS

• USBC has provided standard logos for each association to ACA. Examples:





- If more customizing is requested, please contact your Regional Manager
- · Using the national logo will provide larger bulk order discounting

4.DETERMINE ORDERING & PURCHASING PROCEDURE FOR AWARDS

- · With ACA, you will have the option to order online, by phone, fax or mail.
- · What method of payment will be used?
- What price point do you want to achieve?
- · How will you keep track of what is ordered?
 - Invoices
 - Receipts
 - Log book- excel spreadsheet
- Design a form of documentation to track order dates and amount paid

5.DETERMINE THE DISTRIBUTION & TRACKING METHOD FOR THE AWARDS

- · Build an awards form
 - League secretaries need to be notified of what the award criteria will be
 - Work with them to input the local awards into BLS or Treasure software
- Put plan together on how, when, and who will distribute the awards
- Design time frame for awards distribution- within 10 days of receipt of award earned, etc...
- · Awards tracking can still be done in WinLABS

6.COMMUNICATE TO LOCAL MEMBERS, PROPRIETORS, & SECRETARIES ABOUT THE NEW AWARDS PROGRAM
