Proposed legislation for 2022 USBC Convention

The deadline to submit a proposed amendment to be considered at the 2022 USBC Convention is nearing. Per the USBC national bylaws, written amendment proposals to bylaws and adult league and tournament rules must be received by USBC Headquarters on or before the Sept. 1 prior to the next USBC Annual Meeting. For those who want to submit an amendment proposal, please be mindful of this deadline.

Bring Bowlers Back - National Bowling Day


Saturday (Aug. 14) is National Bowling Day!
