SafeSport MAAP Policy

As an association leader with USBC, you should be aware of, and understand, the U.S. Center for SafeSport's 2022 Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP). USBC's version of the MAAPP's are included in the Athlete Safety/RVP Handbook in Section III.

To give you an overview of the MAAPP's, including recent changes, and to answer your questions, the U.S. Center for SafeSport is providing free live MAAPP trainings – tailored specifically for your role as an athlete, parent, coach or administrator. This training is NOT required, but simply a supplement for those who wish to know more about the programs SafeSport has to offer.

You can register for these virtual trainings at <u>this Center web page</u>. Numerous trainings will take place each month, so check back periodically for calendar updates.



Membership Card Date of Birth

As a follow-up to three weeks ago, all memberships now are required to have an accurate date of birth on their profile, or they will not be able to be processed. You will see this in your existing leagues that are moved to inactive with the start of the new season, as the check box to activate the bowler is grayed out. You will need to add in a member's DOB first, to be able to sell them a membership.

We appreciate your assistance in providing this extra customer service and processing the leagues and memberships as they come in. Ensuring accurate dates of birth is essential to keeping up with compliance with SafeSport and USOPC mandates regarding adult/youth leagues and youth/adult interactions. Thank you in advance for helping keep your WinLABS and USBC databases accurate.



WinLABS Tutorials

With the start of the 2021-2022 season, it never hurts to get refreshed on the best practices for WinLABS! Proposed legislation for 2022 USBC Convention

Per the USBC national bylaws, written amendment proposals to bylaws and adult league and tournament rules must be received by USBC Headquarters on or before Sept. 1, prior to the next USBC Annual Meeting. For those who want to submit an amendment proposal, please be mindful of this deadline.
