Pink Facts

What causes breast cancer? When cells divide and grow without their normal control breast cancer occurs. There are different types of breast cancer, including non-invasive, invasive, and metastatic breast cancer.

- Ductal carcinoma in situ or DCIS (non-invasive) – Abnormal cell growth inside the milk ducts that has not spread to other tissue
- Lobular carcinoma in situ or LCIS (non-invasive) – Abnormal cell growth inside the lobules that has not spread to other tissue

- Invasive breast cancer – Abnormal cell growth moves to nearby lymph nodes and other body parts
- Metastatic breast cancer – Abnormal cell growth that has moved beyond the breast and nearby tissue to other body parts
