According to Susan G. Komen, one in eight U.S. women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime. In order to be proactive, it is important to self-check and be aware of any abnormalities/changes with your body. Breast cancer warning signs to be aware of are:

- A lump, hard knot, or thickening inside the breast or underarm area
- Swelling, warmth, redness, or darkening
- Irritation, dimpling, or puckering of the skin
- New pain in one spot that doesn't disappear
