# **Grant Assistance**

### **Program**


The United States Bowling Congress, Bowling Proprietors' Association of America and The Bowling Foundation partnering with the YES Fund will award four \$2,500 grants to help start a high school bowling program or to help supplement a program that lost funding because of school budget cuts.

#### **Requirements for application:**

- 1. Must be either:
  - a. A high school that does not have a high school bowling program (club or varsity) or b. Must be a current varsity program in which the school has pulled funding for the team
- 2. Grant application must be completed in its entirety.
- 3. Grant application must be signed by principal or athletic director of the high school.
- 4. Letter from school principal, athletic director or school board that states funding for a team does not exist in current school budget.
- 5. Please provide a history of the program. How long has it existed? How has it been funded? How many student-athletes are currently participating?
- 6. Supporting materials that a program is wanted and can be operational, including coaching provided, interested student-athletes, bowling center agreement for practice time and competitions, etc.
- A comprehensive budget for the team. This includes promotional materials, cost of lineage for practice/ competitions, transportation, uniforms, etc.
- 8. A comprehensive plan on how the team will be funded beyond grant award along with a 3-5 year plan to fund the program into the future.
- 9. Competition plan. (i.e. who will the team compete against, number of competitions for the year, etc.)
- 10. Team members must have USBC Youth membership through your local USBC association or bowling center. For more information, visit www.BOWL.com/highschool.

Grant applications along with supporting materials must be returned to USBC High School. Applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis upon submission. Grant recipients will be notified in writing.
