THE LEGENDARY EARL ANTHONY won 41 Professional Bowlers Association National Tour Titles and seven PBA Senior Titles. A member of both the PBA and USBC Halls of Fame, he was the first pro bowler to achieve more than \$1 million in career earnings.

A low key competitor with an accurate, consistent and controlled style that lead many to call him "The Machine," Anthony displayed true concern for youth bowlers' success. In 1980 he partnered with the American Junior Bowling Congress in a national contest for youth to "Beat Earl Anthony," launching what later morphed into the popular "Beat the Coach" challenge that many USBC Youth leagues still conduct today.

USBC's Earl Anthony Memorial Scholarship was launched in 2004, three years after Anthony's death.

This Scholarship is awarded annually to five USBC Youth members.

THE EARL ANTHONY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP annually recognizes five USBC Youth bowlers for their community involvement and academic achievements. Five winners will be chosen and awarded \$5,000 scholarships.

The United States Bowling Congress presents this prestigious scholarship in honor of the late Earl Anthony. Anthony was dedicated to helping youth bowlers and USBC is proud to continue these efforts in his name.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be a current USBC Youth member in their senior year of high school or enrolled in college
- 2. Be a USBC Youth member in good standing
- 3. Have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
- 4. Completed application
- 5. Include at least two letters of reference (by a teacher, principal, employer, etc.)
- 6. Include an official or unofficial school transcript
- 7. Return all completed documentation and application to USBC post-marked no later than **DECEMBER 1, 2016**. (Partial or incomplete applications will not be accepted.)
