KERM HELMER HORIZON AWARD NOMINATION FORM

KERM HELMER dedicated his life to the growth and development of youth and collegiate bowling. A physical education teacher for more than 35 years, Helmer initiated men's and women's bowling programs at Erie Community College in Buffalo, NY. As a coach, he led the Kats to 15 National Junior College Athletic Association men's titles and 22 NJCAA women's titles. His men's and women's teams each claimed a pair of national titles at what is now known as the USBC Intercollegiate Team Championships as well.

A longtime member of the American Bowling Congress/Women's International Bowling Congress Collegiate Committee, Helmer also served several years as the Association of College Unions International Singles Championships tournament director. A director on the ABC and Young American Bowling Alliance boards from 1986 until his death in 2002; he was YABA president from 1999 to 2001.

The Kerm Helmer Horizon Award was developed in his memory to recognize visionary leadership. The inaugural award was presented to Helmer posthumously in 2003.

Nominate that special person whose efforts have developed far-reaching national opportunities and programs for collegiate and youth bowlers.

THE KERM HELMER HORIZON AWARD annually recognizes leaders or organizations in the bowling community who have displayed the courage, determination and ability to develop far-reaching programs of national-scope that provide fun and exciting

opportunities for collegiate and/or youth bowlers. The award recipient receives an expense-paid trip to the awards ceremony held in conjunction with the USBC Convention in the spring.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. A person or organization may be nominated for this award
2. Any person or organization may be a nominator
3. A nominee cannot be:
 - A. Currently on the USBC National Board or;
 - B. Have been on the USBC National Board within the previous two years.
4. The completed nomination, nomination statement, and any supporting documentation must be post-marked no later than **DECEMBER 1, 2016**, to be considered. Applications will be held for two years for consideration of the award.
