



How to Create a USBC Community Login

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Overview

The United States Bowling Congress (USBC) is implementing the use of a single sign-on login and password for applications. To access USBC applications and services, users must create a USBC Community login. This login can be used to access many of the USBC applications and member features such as BOWL.com, Find_a_Member, Registration, Collegiate Tournament Portal, Junior Gold Qualifier Portal, among various other tools.




This document provides the step-by-step directions on how to create and manage your USBC Community Login ID. By the end of this document, you will have a full understanding of how to:

Login with Existing Community Login Account

Applications that require a user to access the app by Community Login will provide the user a login screen. The application name is identified within the red banner.

To log in, users enter their Username and password and click Log In.

Create a USBC Community Login Account

Users who do not have a Community Login can create one from the same application login screen.



Click **Sign Up for a USBC Community Account** at the bottom of the login screen.

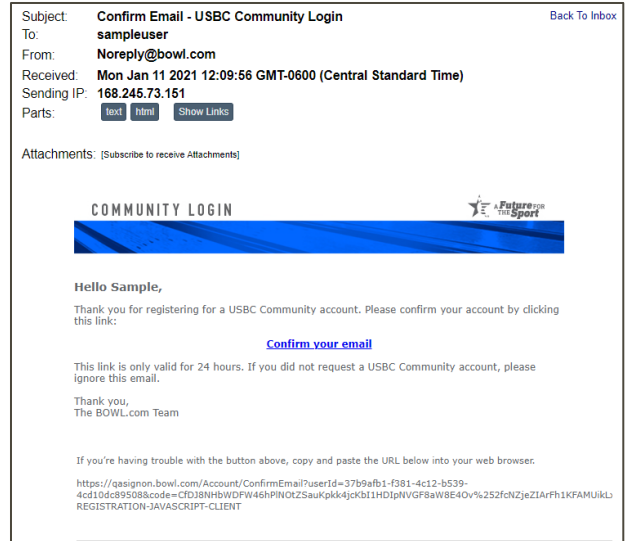

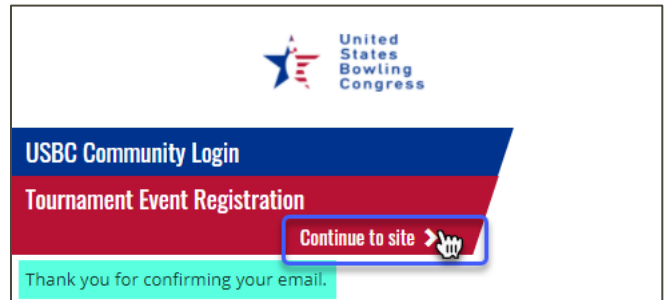

Users will be redirected to the application login screen and should click **Continue to Site**.



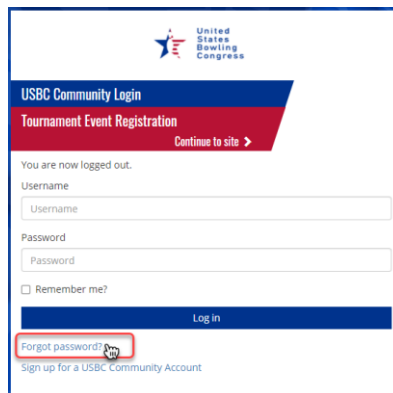
Users can [Login with an Existing Community ID](#) and are granted access to the application.

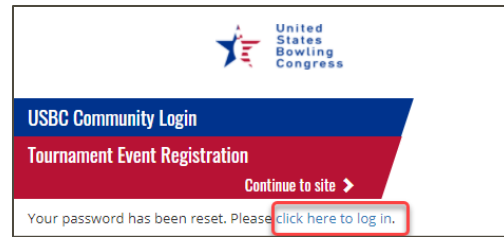

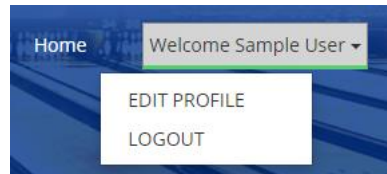

Manage a USBC Community Login Account

Once logged in, users can access their profile by using the down arrow next to their name in the upper righthand corner of the application.

*note - (as of 1/1/2021) Updates done in Community profile do not update a user's Membership data. Please continue to call Membership services to update any name, address, or other personal data.


The profile screen will display all the information the user entered upon creation of the Community account. In addition to the personal data, there are several other ways a user can manage their profile in this screen. Below are the most common ways.



Update/Change Email

Once logged in users can update their and information including their email. Using Edit Profile, users can type over their email.

After the changes are saved, the user will need to **Send confirmation email** to reconfirm the new email.









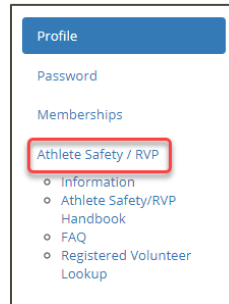

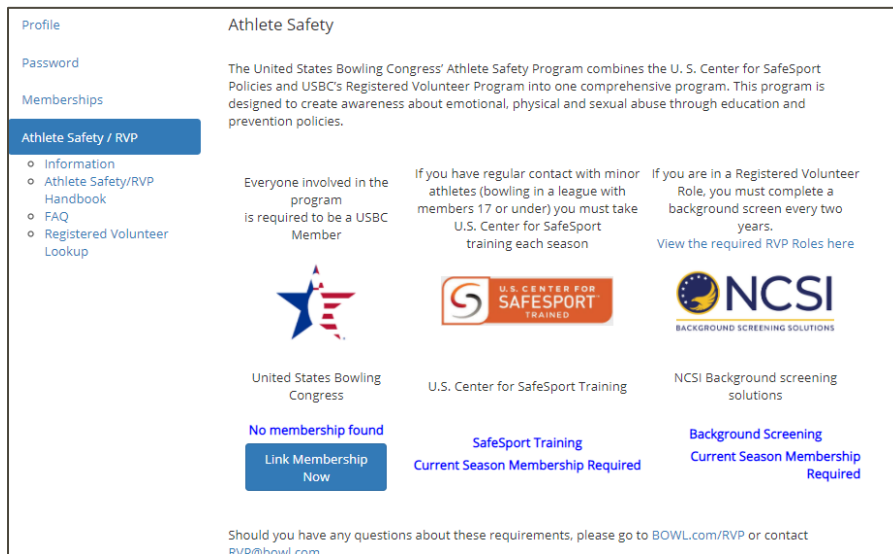


Review Athlete Safety and RVP Status
