Sweet Home Chicago



The United States Bowling Congress Women's Championships is returning to the Chicagoland area for the first time in more than 85 years, and YOU get to be part of the historic return in 2022.

The event previously was held in the Windy City in 1920 and 1935, and the tournament is making its debut in Addison, Illinois, at the 84-lane Stardust Bowl for its 102nd edition.

Stardust Bowl has been a staple in the Addison community for more than 50 years and is the largest bowling center in the state of Illinois. In fact, it's one of the largest bowling centers in the United States!

While Stardust Bowl certainly is a large venue, you'll feel right at home with the service provided at this family-owned center. Not only is the staff used to busy league nights, but the center has hosted its fair share of national events over the years, too.

Tournaments like the Junior Gold Championships and the U.S. Women's Open have been held at Stardust Bowl in the last few years, and it also is hosting the Intercollegiate Team and Singles Championships and USBC Queens in 2022.

You know you'll have a great time on the lanes, but we know bowling is just the beginning when making a trip to the Women's Championships.

The experience in 2022 has plenty of possibilities, whether you're staying closer

to the suburbs in Addison and DuPage County or venturing to Chicago and all of the excitement the big city has to offer.

Addison and Stardust Bowl is less than 30 miles away from the heart of downtown Chicago. We're talking about the Willis Tower, State Street, Millennium Park and Navy Pier. They're all right there and about 30 minutes away.

Chicago's museums are legendary. Kick off your day like Ferris Bueller by visiting the Art Institute of Chicago, or check out must-see stops like the Field Museum, Museum of Science and Industry, Shedd Aquarium, Adler Planetarium or Chicago History Museum.

Deep-dish pizza is a staple in the area, with spots like Lou Malnati's Pizzeria and Giordano's fighting for the top billing in the city. The good news? You win with either selection (or perform your own taste test and check out both).

Do you know all of the ingredients on a Chicago-style hot dog? We had to look them up, too, but there's a little bit of everything packed into these delicious treats (except ketchup).

How do you like your Italian beef sandwich? They'll ask you if you want it

dipped, regular or dry at Al's Beef, the originator of the Chicago favorite.

For dessert, it's popcorn. Specifically, from the famous Garrett Popcorn Shops. You'll want to bring a tin home to share with all the bowlers in your league ... but be sure to bring an extra one for yourself.

We could continue with all the great things to do while visiting Chicago, but we also know you may be looking to stay close to Stardust Bowl, too. After all those strikes and spares during your team event, you may want to keep it local in preparation for doubles and singles the following day.

Along with countless dining options, spend the day with nature at the Morton Arboretum in Lisle, catch a performance at the Drury Lane Theatre in Oakbrook Terrace or hit the links at one of the 50-plus golf courses in DuPage County.

Between bowling, fun and adventure, the trip to the Chicagoland area for the 2022 Women's Championships offers it all. KNOW YOUR AVERAGE

At the USBC Women's Championships, each participant is placed into an average-based division for team, doubles, singles and all-events.

To determine the proper entering average for the 2022 event, our friendly and helpful staff members first will check to see if you have established a Championships Average. A Championships Average is based on your most recent 27 games bowled at the Women's Championships since 2013.

If you don't have a Championships Average, our staff will have a few additional questions to determine your average for the event. It will take just a couple of minutes at the registration desk, and you'll be set to go.

Remember, though, that the averages used at the Women's Championships are adjusted down to reflect Challenge conditions. If you have any questions, just ask when your team is checking in for the 2022 event.

TWICE AS NICE

Colorado's Sharon Powers continues to build her resume at the national level with another win at the USBC Women's Championships.

Sharon Powers of Lakewood, Colorado, achieved a goal 44 years in the making when she helped her team capture the Diamond title at the 2019 USBC Women's Championships in Wichita, Kansas.

The 65-year-old right-hander wasted no time adding a second victory during the 2021 event at the famed National Bowling Stadium in Reno, Nevada, as she was able to put together one of the top individual performances in tournament history – in her 45th consecutive tournament appearance – to win Diamond Singles with an 801 series.

Her recent run of success at the Women's Championships, coupled with a pair of wins at the International Golden Ladies Classic and a growing collection of medals with Senior Team USA, has helped prove the adage that age is just a number, and Powers has no intentions of seeing the number of strikes she rolls slow down anytime soon.

Powers' story at the Women's Championships began at the 1976 event in Denver, bowling alongside her mother and sister. As she continued to progress in the sport, she found herself teaming with some of the biggest names in the game, including Lorrie Nichols, Shirley Garms, Robin Romeo and Nellie Glandon.

Her teams were competitive, and she was no stranger to recording top-10 finishes. At the 1984 event in Niagara Falls, New York, she nearly broke through for a win in Classic Singles, falling one pin short of the top spot.

"I missed tying by one pin," Powers said. "I remember leaving a 2-4-5, so I could have won singles that year."

As Powers returned to the event each year with dreams of making her run to the top of the leaderboard, things just didn't work out the way she hoped – until she walked through the doors at Northrock Lanes for the 100th edition of the Women's Championships in 2019.

She led a dominating performance by Lakewood’s Powerhouse, rolling games of 243, 287 and 255 for a 785 series to help the four-player team to a 2,767 score. Powers and her teammates – Christine Gill, Michelle Maly and Debbie McMullen – won the Diamond title by 85 pins.

“I was so excited,” Powers said. “I think it was a relief, but it was one of my goals – to win one title. It didn’t matter if it was in team, doubles, singles or all-events. Sometimes, I wish my mom (Marjorie Powers) was around to know I had finally done it. She was my main supporter all those years and was the one who got me into bowling.”

The Powerhouse quartet had to wait nearly two years to return to the Women’s Championships for their title defense, after the 2020 event was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The title defense fell short of the score posted in 2019, and the team finished with an eventual 20th-place score in 2021. It turned out the fireworks at the NBS were scheduled for the next day.

After a slow start in doubles, Powers ended up making a ball change toward the end of her first three-game set, noticing the right lane was hooking more than the left lane, and she was able to find her rhythm and the right look.

Powers converted a spare to start her singles block and then rolled 10 consecutive strikes for a 289 game out of the gates. She followed with a nine-strike 268.

She struck on seven of her first eight shots in Game 3. She recorded a spare in the ninth frame to set up the excitement for her final frame.

Powers needed a mark to go around England’s Verity Crawley, who was leading with a 793 series. A mark also would give her the opportunity to become just

the 10th bowler in tournament history to record an 800 series.

A 10 pin stood on her first delivery in the 10th frame, and she covered the spare without issue. A seven count on her fill ball gave her a 244 game and just enough count for another special place in the record book.

Michelle Feldman of Auburn, New York, is the only other bowler at the event to roll an 800 series in singles competition. She fired an 816 set to win Classic Singles in 2009, also at the 78-lane NBS.

“I knew I had to pick up the 10 pin for 800, and I was just happy to pick it up and get to 801,” said Powers moments after her historic performance. “I didn’t know what the lead was, so all I wanted to do was make the 10 pin. I’m thrilled to accomplish this.”

Powers had more than a month to see if her score would hold for a second consecutive win at the event, and she kept tabs often on BOWL.com to make sure her name remained at the top of the leaderboard.

After the final ball was rolled at the NBS and scores were verified and official, she was able to reflect on another victory and the impressive run she’s experienced at the national level in the last several years.

“I have more confidence in myself,” said Powers, who kicked off 2022 with a win at the Greater Denver USBC Queens. “Knowing I now have two titles and am getting better as I get older, I’m more confident in myself and what I’m doing.”

In addition to her confidence growing with each strong performance, Powers also has seen her game flourish in recent years after retiring from her job in the federal government for United States Geological Survey in 2011.

Retiring has allowed her to put more focus on her game, instead of worrying about what she might be coming back to after a trip out of town to compete.

“It’s so much easier to practice and travel when you don’t have to worry about work,” Powers said. “Before, when I would go on a trip, they would pile up on the work. Now, it’s so much easier to concentrate on what I want to do and to concentrate on getting better.”

Powers’ travel schedule has kept her busy, with annual stops at events like the USBC Senior Queens and International Golden Ladies Classic to go along with her appearance each year at the Women’s Championships.

As part of Senior Team USA, she’s traveled to Calgary, Alberta, Canada, for the 2018 PANAM Senior Championships, and Las Vegas (2019) and Dubai, United Arab Emirates (2021) for the International Bowling Federation Masters (formerly Senior) World Championships.

She also represented the United States at the 2015 Lee Evans Tournament of the Americas in Sunrise, Florida. She has collected more than a dozen medals in international competition.

As Powers continued to pile on-lane accolades, the Greater Denver and Colorado State USBC Hall of Famer’s story and victory at the 2021 Women’s Championships were highlighted in the September 2021 issue of *Bowlers Journal International* magazine, where she graced the cover of the longest-running monthly sports magazine in the nation.

“It was a neat experience,” Powers said. “We had to order more copies, because everyone in town wanted me to sign a copy of it. It is so unreal to look at that and say ‘that’s me.’ That’s kind of the cherry on top of everything.”

2021 -RECAP-



The 101st edition of the USBC Women's Championships featured plenty of high scores, big moments and good times for competitors at the famed National Bowling Stadium in Reno, Nevada. Join us as we relive some of the highlights from The Biggest Little City in the World!

RECORD-SETTING RUN IN DOUBLES

Colombia's Maria José Rodriguez and Guatemala's Sofia Granda put together a doubles performance for the ages at the NBS, joining forces to post the first 1,500-plus set in tournament history on the way to claiming the Diamond Doubles title with a 1,560 total.

Rodriguez, a two-time major champion on the Professional Women's Bowling Association Tour, led the effort with games of 245, 279 and 286 for an 810 series. Granda, who was making her debut at the Women's Championships, added games of 225, 269 and 256 for a 750 set.

The previous doubles record at the Women's Championships belonged to USBC Hall of Famers Lynda Barnes and Carolyn Dorin-Ballard, who captured the title in 2004 with a 1,498 total.

NO TEAM? NO PROBLEM FOR ZULKIFLI

Shalin Zulkifli is one of the most accomplished bowlers on the planet, winning more than 90 medals while representing Malaysia in international competition.

Prior to her trip to the United States to compete in the 2021 USBC Queens in Reno, Zulkifli found herself without a spot on a team for the Women's Championships.

So ... what did she do? She headed to the tournament's on-site sub board, found a team looking for a bowler and proceeded to average more than 250 for her nine games to win Diamond All-Events with a 2,253 total, the third highest nine-game score in the history of the Women's Championships.

Zulkifli's run to the top score included sets of 782 in team, 752 in doubles and 719 in singles.

KUHLKIN, AIEZZA FIND WINNER'S CIRCLE AFTER CLOSE CALL IN 2019

Liz Kuhlkin of Schenectady, New York, and Jessica Aiezza of Mechanicville, New York, just missed winning Diamond Doubles at the 2019 Women's Championships in Wichita, Kansas, finishing second by just six pins.

They didn't plan to be denied in 2021, and with the help of Robin Orlikowski of Grand Rapids, Michigan, and Suzanne Morine of Castleton, New York, they rolled the top team score at the NBS to help Mechanicville's Bowl 2 Win capture the

Diamond Team title with a 2,809 total.

The team rolled games of 883, 1,003 and 923 to catapult to the top of the leaderboard.

Kuhlkin, a two-time PWBA Tour champion, led the way with a 752 series and was followed by Orlikowski (704), Aiezza (696) and Morine (657).

The 1,003 team game and 2,809 team series are the second-highest scores in each category since the introduction of four-player teams at the 2014 Women's Championships.

THREE BOWLERS WIN TWO TITLES IN 2021

Three competitors at the 2021 Women's Championships found themselves at the top of the leaderboard in multiple events when the final ball was rolled at the Taj Mahal of Tenpins.

Shalanda Nunn of Lafayette, Indiana, claimed wins in Sapphire Singles and Sapphire All-Events with her performance, posting scores of 671 in singles and 1,740 in all-events.

Nunn used games of 237, 253 and 181 to take the top spot in singles, and she added sets of 587 in team and 482 in doubles to roll to the top of the standings in all-events.

Rebecca Grant of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, recorded wins in Topaz Doubles and Topaz All-Events at the NBS with scores of 907 and 1,506, respectively.

Grant paired with Diena Wasson of Enumclaw, Washington, to win Topaz Doubles, with Grant leading the way with a 531 series. Wasson added 376.

Grant's all-events win also included sets of 514 in singles and 461 in team. She had taken the lead in Topaz Singles, too, but she settled for a runner-up finish after Joan Boesen of Bullhead City, Arizona, passed her to capture the win with a 518 series.

Malinda Carpenter of Colville, Washington, picked up a pair of titles in the Amethyst Division.

She took home Amethyst Doubles with Sharold Moser of Addy, Washington, with a 1,072 total. Carpenter rolled a 573 series, and Moser added 499 in the winning effort.

Carpenter added 520 in team and 474 in singles to also claim the top spot in Amethyst All-Events with a 1,567 total.

TWO FIND PERFECTION AT NBS

A pair of bowlers recorded 300 games during the 2021 event, bringing the tournament's total to 34 perfect games in 101 years of competition.

Tina Williams of Pflugerville, Texas, was the first to connect for 12 consecutive strikes at the 2021 event, kicking off her doubles set with a 300 game on her way to a 737 series.

Williams, a member of the USBC Board of Directors, added sets of 745 in singles and 713 in team to finish in fifth place in Diamond All-Events with a 2,195 total.

Karen Barcal of Albuquerque, New Mexico, added her name to the record book during her team event, but she was ready for more excitement the following day during her doubles and singles set.

Barcal rolled 300 during her final team game to finish with a 724 series. After starting her doubles set the next day with 245, she rolled 11 consecutive strikes for 299 in Game 2 on her way to a 787 set. She finished singles with a 576 series to post an all-events score of 2,087, placing her in the top 25 in Diamond All-Events.

If she would have connected for the second perfect game, Barcal would have become the second bowler in tournament history to own multiple 300 games at the event, joining USBC and PWBA Hall of Famer Jeanne Naccarato.

HEATH-TROTT JOINS 50-YEAR CLUB

Ruth Heath-Trott of Montpelier, Ohio, was the lone bowler at the 2021 Women's

Championships to make her 50th appearance on the championship lanes.

Heath-Trott, the recipient of the 2017 Helen Baker Award for Outstanding Association Service, began her tournament career at the 1970 event in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and only missed one appearance on her way to the participation milestone. She received a plaque, chevron and pendant to recognize the achievement.

Heath-Trott, the president of the Ohio State USBC, has earned induction into four halls of fame in Ohio based on her service, dedication and performance in the sport.

USBC QUEENS TAKES OVER NBS

Julia Bond of Aurora, Illinois, captured her first major title on the Professional Women's Bowling Association Tour by winning the 2021 United States Bowling Congress Queens at the National Bowling Stadium.

The USBC Queens typically is held during the Women's Championships each year, and Bond was able to post an undefeated record through the tournament's famed double-elimination bracket on the way to the win.

Bond defeated Missy Parkin of Laguna Hills, California, in the title match on BowlTV, 238-154.



Coldwater, Michigan

Onalee Kraus will celebrate her sixth decade at the Women's Championships and join the tournament's most exclusive participation club during her appearance this year at Stardust Bowl.

She will become the fifth bowler in tournament history to become a member of the 60-Year Club on the championship lanes, and she'll be the first competitor to reach the milestone since USBC Hall of Famer Anita Cantaline of Warren, Michigan, celebrated her 60th appearance in 2009.

Kraus' first appearance at the Women's Championships was at the 1957 event in Dayton, Ohio, and she has made the annual trek to the tournament nearly every year since her debut.

The tournament has helped her travel to 41 cities and 26 states throughout the years, and her stop in Addison in 2022 will add another new city to her list.

One of her favorite trips was to Toledo, Ohio, for the 1985 event, when she was part of the Women's International Bowling Congress Board of Directors. Her favorite part of her journey, though, has been making new friends from all over the country.

"I have many bowling friends from all over," said Kraus, who was able to join her teammates as the grand marshal for their team event at the 2021 Women's Championships. "I keep in touch with a lot of the girls I have met."






