Why we need volunteer coaches

- The backbone of youth sports is volunteers
- Simply said...
 - You HAVE to have them
 - Coaching = Retention
- Volunteers make youth sports successful
 - AYSO
 - 500,000 kids
 - 50 paid employees
 - 150,000 volunteers





Recruiting volunteer coaches

- Be on the look out for the right fit!
 - Good communication skills
 - Good time management skills
 - Role model figures
- Ask for 8-12 weeks of commitment
- Your volunteers are usually already in your bowling center!!!!



Recruiting volunteer coaches

- Who should I recruit to volunteer?
 - Parents
 - Graduating youth league players
 - Local high school or college bowlers
 - Existing adult league bowlers
 - Bowling center staff (off the clock)





Registered Volunteer Program

- www.bowl.com/rvp
- RVP is a USBC program designed to keep individuals with criminal records out of USBC Youth programs
- Most youth sports organizations require volunteers go through a background screening
- It is highly suggested that your volunteers become approved by USBC RVP.



Training for volunteer coaches

 "There is common agreement that the quality of the youth sports experience depends on the competence of the adult leaders; most specifically, the coach. Thus, educational programs for volunteer coaches would seem to be in demand, but such is not the case."

Training for volunteer coaches

- USA Bowling Coaching
 - Grass Roots seminar program
 - Delivered to youth volunteer instructors through seminars across the country
 - Options to host a seminar
 - 50 FREE seminars awarded annually to BPAA member centers and USBC Associations
 - \$200 Seminar curriculum and presentation
 - \$500 Seminar curriculum, presentation, and instructor
